The goals of this course are to provide tools to caregivers to support and for individuals with developmental disabilities to develop a positive sense of his/her sexuality, enhance his/her sense of self esteem, develop a pattern of socially acceptable behavior, to learn skills to apply his/her knowledge to his/her living situation, and to determine and express his/her attitudes and values.

Karen Brinegar-Price is an Employment Supervisor with Vocational Services at The Arc Northern Chesapeake Region. Karen has been continuing her education and conducted trainings on Human Sexuality and Relationships for the past nine years. Most recently, Karen created and taught the RSVP Program- Relationships, Sexuality, Values that are Personalized to adults receiving services through The Arc. In addition, Karen has brought aboard a co-presenter, Damarcus Coleman. Damarcus holds an AA Degree from Harford Community College and is an Employment Specialist with Vocational Services at The Arc.
