



What is Treatment Foster Care?

- Children served in this program have entered foster care because of abuse and/or neglect and have been identified as having special needs.
- Foster parents become part of a treatment team with biological parents, social workers, therapists, Department of Social Services staff, and other professionals who work together to create a successful plan of services for a child.
- Each child has a treatment plan and foster parents have the responsibility, along with other members of the team, to develop, implement, and evaluate that plan.
